MALBEC

The best Malbec in the world is grown in Argentina. The conditions & climate required for the grape to grow are perfect here. Malbec is without doubt 'THE' grape to go with beef, mainly due to its firm tannins & soft, fresh style. The most highly rated wines come from Mendoza's high-altitude regions of Lujan de Cuyo & the Uco Valley. These districts are in the foothills of the Andes Mountains between 800m & 1500m above sea-level. The jewel in Argentina's crown, not only is Malbec the perfect match for beef, it also works brilliantly with chocolate – what is there not to like!

'Thorny Devil' Grenache, Barossa Valley, Australia 2016

This Barossa wine is both powerful & elegant, silky fruit texture with spice brambles. Easy drinking – a perfect lunchtime red.

Riecine Chianti Classico, Tuscany, Italy 2016

The wine is 100% Sangiovese made in a classical style, medium bodied with lots of fruit character, light tannins & a spicy finish.

Nelson Estate Shiraz, Paarl, South Africa 2012

Rich & full-bodied with dark chocolate; aromas of blackberries, cigar box & mocha – a super smooth Shiraz.

Two Paddocks Pinot Noir, Central Otago, New Zealand 2016

This dry, medium bodied Pinot Noir complements rich meats exquisitely. A generous helping of black & red cherries on the palate with mixed spice & a smooth, exceptional finish.

Prunotto Barolo, Piedmont, Italy 2014

Made from the Nebbiolo grape, this wine is a perfect match with red meat – intense aromas of cherries & blackberries, with a vanilla coffee finish.

Gevrey Chambertin, Domaine Rossignol-Trapet, Vieilles Vignes, Burgundy, France 2014

An excellent value Pinot Noir, one of the best village level wines of the region – rich, deep & elegant.

'The McRae Wood' Shiraz, Jim Barry, Clare Valley, Australia 2012

A rich, concentrated wine with flavours of red & black fruits along with toasty oak – having had 17 months in oak. Drinking very well just now. This is the baby brother of their iconic 'The Armagh'.

L'Hospitalet de Gazin, Pomerol, Bordeaux, France 2012

The 2nd wine of Chateau Gazin, next door to Petrus. Dark rich fruits, with a concentrated plummy finish – this Cabernet led Bordeaux is classy. Would benefit from being decanted.

Amarone della Valpolicella (Tedeschi), Italy 2015

This Amarone is a real beauty! A blend of Corvina, Corvinone & Rondinella. A touch of vanilla from 3 years in oak, this wine is velvety smooth, strong, powerful & superbly balanced with concentrated fruit.

Paul Hobb's 'Crossbarn' Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, USA 2014

Produced using hand-harvested fruit from carefully selected vineyards within the Napa Valley, this Cabernet led powerhouse offers aromas of wild berry, sweet tobacco & all-spice. Fine grain tannins with an energetic & lively finish.

Chateauneuf du Pape, Tardieu – Laurent, Rhone Valley, France 2012

Both powerful & light, this wine is perfectly balanced, led with 85% Grenache.

Torbreck Kylee, Barossa Valley, Australia 2011

Named after our very own restaurant, this wine goes hand in hand with our beef. Made using 100% Mataro grapes, the wine is wild & hearty just like a true Kylee beast.

Le Cigare Volant, Bonny Doon Vineyard, USA 2011

Big fashionable Rhone style blend from Santa Cruz, California. Cigar box on the nose, peppery, dark, warm & rich. A true icon!

Brokenwood 'Graveyard' Shiraz, Hunter Valley, NSW, Australia 2002

This iconic wine of the Hunter Valley is very highly rated. Medium bodied with fine tannins – flavours of blackberry, vanilla & plum. This Shiraz is ideally suited to beef & venison.

Silver Oak Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, USA 2013

25 months in new American oak & a further 20 months aged in the bottle has delivered an elegant wine with a complex nose of cedar wood, ground coffee & cassis – iconic!

Jim Barry 'The Armagh' Shiraz, Clare Valley, Australia 2002

This inky Shiraz boasts bold notes of cassis, dark chocolate, scorched earth & leather. Marvellous balance of acidity, tannins & alcohol with a stunning long finish. Not to be missed!

Ridge Monte Bello, Santa Cruz Mountains, California USA 2014

Intense blackcurrant & blackberry fruit aromas, with barrel spice & liquorice. Made using 75% Cab Sauv 18% Merlot, 5% Cab Franc & 2% Petit Verdot. The tannins are full & chalky, with a strong sweet oak finish. Decanting is a must.

Penfolds 'Grange' Shiraz, South Australia 1998

Stunning purple in colour, accompanied by exceptionally sweet aromas of blackberry liqueur intermixed with barbecue spices, mocha & a smoky earthiness. Profoundly concentrated but velvety smooth & impressively muscular, this exquisite wine is a candidate for perfection.

Petit Verdot, Ruca Malen, Mendoza, Argentina 2014 £38

A fantastic wine – intense, full bodied, smooth, spicy, elegant, oak aged for 12 months.

Quinta de Chocapalha, Estremadura-Lisboa, Portugal 2015 £38

A blend of Touriga Nacional & Tinto Roriz, this red is deeply coloured with flavours of cassis & pink pepper spice. Perfect with red meat.
